Introduction:-

Tapananda Rural Development Society (TRDS) was established in the year 1990. This is voluntary organization inspired by the ideals of Swami Vivekananda in the light of Swami Tapananda's vision of rural development "bring the life in all its completeness the villagers self-reliant and self – sufficient".

Comprehensive Development Programs encompassing socio-economic and ideological aspects of human life.

Involving grass roots people in planning, decision and implementation of various programs.

The people of the organization support the projects from below poverty line whereas the Executive Committee of TRDS constituted of active persons from various spheres of social life including representatives of grass root organizations. TRDS started works selecting in the drought and underdeveloped area of Purulia District with the prospective urgency of development aids for scheduled casts, scheduled tribes and other poor and weaker section of the society.

Objective:

A. The major objects of the TRDS are to organize, motivate and help the villagers to achieve progressive and development attitude towards poor and illiterate people in general.

B. To improve health consciousness of the people. To improve employment opportunities and income prospects for the poor and illiterate people in general.

C. To eradicate illiteracy.

D. To remove the basic socio-economic and environmental problems of the area, population etc.

E. To develop congenial eco-system of the area for perfect and equal progress of the people who are living in the ignorance of education and illiteracy.

Activities during the year 2017-18

1. Rajib Gandhi National Crèche Program :

TRDS has been running 4 Nos. of Crèche units under Rajib Gandhi National Crèche Units. The scheme sanctioned by CSWB/WBSWB. The names of the villages where the units are situated 1. at village Jharnakocha 2. at village Kudlung 3. at village Bishkudra 4. at village Majiramdih all under Barabazar Block in Purulia District. 25 Nos. of children are in each unit. The age group is 0-5 years from poor families whose mothers are engaged in agriculture field and other works. The children have been provided nutrition on a regular basis and emergency medicines as and when required.

2. Children School (Tapananda Vidya Mandir, Majiramdih):

Since 1990 TRDS has been running a school for the children with residential facilities at village Majiramdih under Sukurutu G.P. in Barabazar Block. The name of the school is "Tapananda Vidya Mandir". The school building has been constructed with the help of local people. The local people donated money as well as labour for construction building. A dug well was constructed for drinking water from MPLAD fund in the year 2005-06.Tapananda Vidya Mandir has obtained recognition from School Education Department, Govt of West Bengal.in the year 2013.

3. Gymnasium Equipments:

Received Grant in Aid from Youth Services Department, Govt of West Bengal for Purchase Gymnasium equipments and the same was purchased by the Organization. in the year ended 2015-16

4. Vermy Compost

The Organization has taken part for produce vermy compost and aware the farmers its necessity in Agriculture and demonstrate in the Krishi Mela, organized by the Govt. of West Bengal at Block level.

5. Self-Helf Group:

Our organization has formed self-help group in the locality with the members of BPL families and the society act as facilitator.

6. Awareness Generation Program:

Since inception our society has been organizing awareness camps among rural people in various type of developmental subjects and issues such as importance of literacy, use of modern technology in agriculture, small savings, children and mothers care, health education, environment, Rule of Law, etc.

7. Literacy Centre:

TRDS has been running a literacy Centre at village Kudlung. SHG members are participating in this centre and continuing the same.

8. Veterinary camp:

Veterinary camp has been organized in the remote village to save the of animals of the marginal farm families. Basic vaccination to the cattle has been given during the camp. Other diseases also treated as required. At the same time discussion were held on cattle rearing with the farmers done at the end of the camp.

9. Children Library:

The organization has running a children Library at the premises of the Society at village Kudlung another at village Majiramdih in the premises of Tapananda Vidyamandir.

10. Women and Child Development:

No one can deny that the enhancement of Women's status ultimately depends on their access to educate, health care, economic upliftment. Besides that in India four millions girls are not in school and this reflects on an undervalue work. But the attainment of this goals may vary and well depend not on waiting for trickle-down policies and programs of Governments, but women's as well as people of communities and efforts to take charge and change their situation through organized action. Child care, their education, health, social status, child right are very essential element in a healthy society. For this reason the society is initiating to educate them and involvement actively in different activities for their sustainable development. During this year we conducted few discussion, meeting, orientation camp with our limited sources and conducted different door for their kind support.

11. Other Information:

The organization has got FCRA registration from the Ministry of Home Affairs, Govt. of India vide No. 147070041 dated 21.4.2010 and also has obtained 12A registration of the I.T.

12. Games and Sports:

Socially disadvantaged groups specially youth members of the society and school children in our tribal areas are the deprived of their right to education of sports and games and culture. Always they are facing various problems in their family and society. It is necessary for physical, mental, redevelopment through games and sports. All this moment the society organized games and sports with local youth and others for their development.

13. Custom Hiring Centre (CHC)

Credit Linked subsidy scheme for Rural Enterprenures to set up Custom Hiring Centre (CHC) of Farm Machinary. A new Scheme of Agriculture Department, Govt. of West Bengal. Custom Hiring Centre (CHC) of Farm Machinaries with the aim of increasing Farm Power by encouraging usage farm machinaries by small and marginal farmers who would otherwise be deprived of this aid by increasing field productivity because of the prohibitive of owning such assets.

14. Ambulance Service:

Our Society has ensured 24 hours Ambulance service in the locality area covered i.e. Sindri PHC and Bari BPHC.

On behalf of our organization we would like to convey thanks to local Panchayet Pradhan, Barabazar Block Administration, Purulia Zilla Parishad and hon'ble District administration for their continuous help and supports.

Auditor report for the year 2017-18 is also placed in the meeting and accepted the same unanimously.
